

# **Direction of Trade Report**

Second Quarter 2020 August 2020

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### **1.0 Introduction**

This Report analyses Zambia's direction of merchandise trade for the second quarter of 2020 in comparison with the corresponding quarter in 2019. Statistics based on the Harmonised Coding System (HS) are reported and exports are valued as free on board (f.o.b.) while imports are reported at cost, including insurance and freight (c.i.f.).

### 2.0 Major Destinations for Zambia's Exports

Major destinations for Zambia's exports were Switzerland, China, Singapore, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Luxembourg, and Hong Kong


Total exports earnings were US\$1.57 billion in the second quarter of 2020, 14.5% lower than the US\$1.83 billion reported in the corresponding quarter in 2019. This was largely due to the fall in copper export earnings from Switzerland and China (Chart 1 and Table 1). Supply chain disruptions, the fall in commodity prices, and subdued global economic activity caused by COVID-19 largely accounted for lower export earnings. There was, however, a notable increase in export earnings from soap and washing detergents to the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Malawi due to heightened demand for sanitary products to combat COVID-19.

### Chart 1: Major Export Destinations (US\$ millions)



The top five export commodities were copper and articles thereof; ores, slag and ash; salt, sulphur and plastering material; lime and cement; inorganic chemicals and compounds of precious metals; as well as sugars and sugar confectionery (Charts 2a and 2b).








# 3.0 Major Source Countries for Zambia's Imports

### Major source countries for Zambia's imports were South Africa, China, United Arab Emirates (UAE), India, DRC, and United States of America

Merchandise imports were US\$1.14 billion in the second quarter of 2020 compared to US\$1.86 billion in the corresponding quarter in 2019, representing a decline of 38.7%. Imports from the top five source countries accounted for 18% of total imports with South Africa being the highest contributor, at 10% (Chart 4). Significant reductions in imports of mineral fuels and vehicles were recorded (Table 2).

Generally, the decline in imports was largely attributed to the COVID-19 related lockdown and other restrictions imposed to prevent the spread of the virus which saw companies scale down operations resulting in weak demand for imported goods. In addition, lower consumer demand


# contributed to the significant fall in the volume of imports.

Chart 5: Major Import Commodities (US\$ millions)







### Chart 6b: Q2 2020 and Q2 2019 Source countries for Fertilisers (US\$ millions)










Chart 6d: Q2 2020 and Q2 2019 Source countries for Mineral Fuels, oils and products of their distillation (US\$ millions)





Chart 6e: Q2 2020 and Q2 2019 Source Countries for Plastics and articles Thereof (US\$ millions)




### 4.0 Conclusion

Trade decreased in the second quarter of 2020 compared to the second quarter of 2019. Export performance declined by 14.5%, reflecting the fall in copper earnings due to the continued downward trend in commodity prices. Imports declined faster at of 38.7%, reflecting supply chain disruptions, subdued domestic economic activity and weak consumer demand.


